






Who are the participants at EU CAP Network events?

How to help pack the participant's suitcase?

- Be inspired by EU CAP Network Program of events and activities
 - the program and topics are known in advance
 - some events could be organized before at local/national level on the same topics
 - who are interested as potential participants at EU CAP Network event could meet each other at local/national level before (experts)
- Spread news and information related to the event at national/local level
- Facilitating participation of local actors (expense support, accompanying to the events, ...)

How to help unpack the participant's suitcase?

- * Be in contact with EU CAP Network
 - monitor and know the local/national participants
- Follow up meetings of local/national participants
- Invite local/national participants as speakers at local/national seminars/WS
- Create communities or stay in touch with local/national participants
- * Ask to the participants suggestion for new contacts
