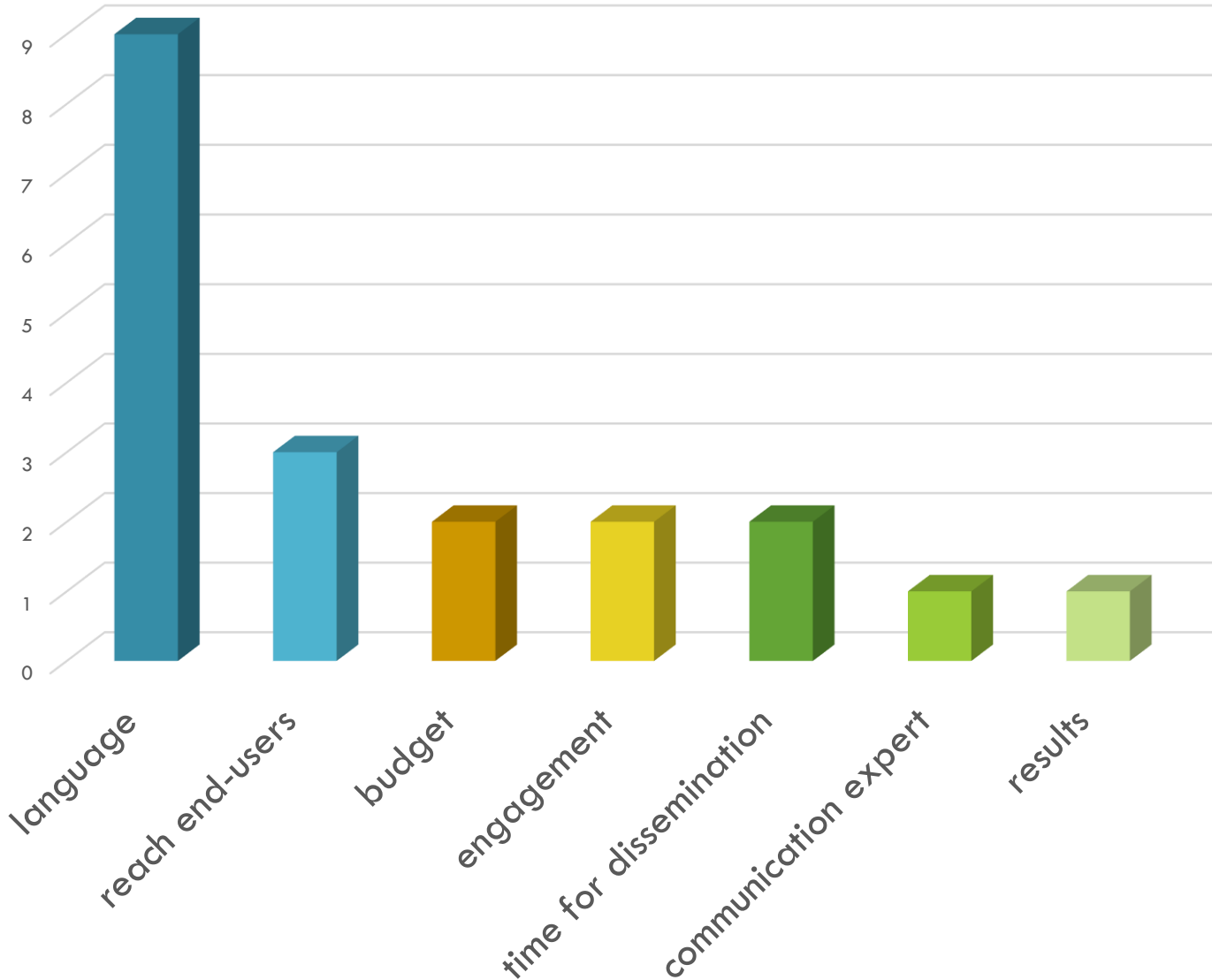

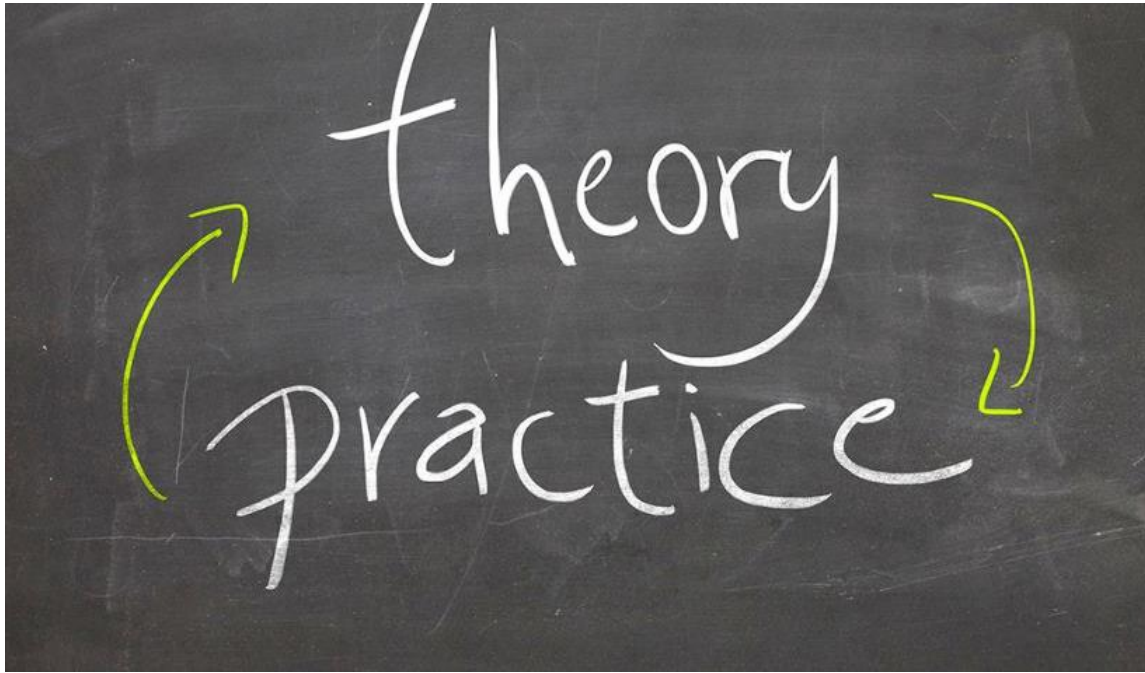

MAJOR DIFFICULTIES FOR THE MULTI-ACTOR APPROACH



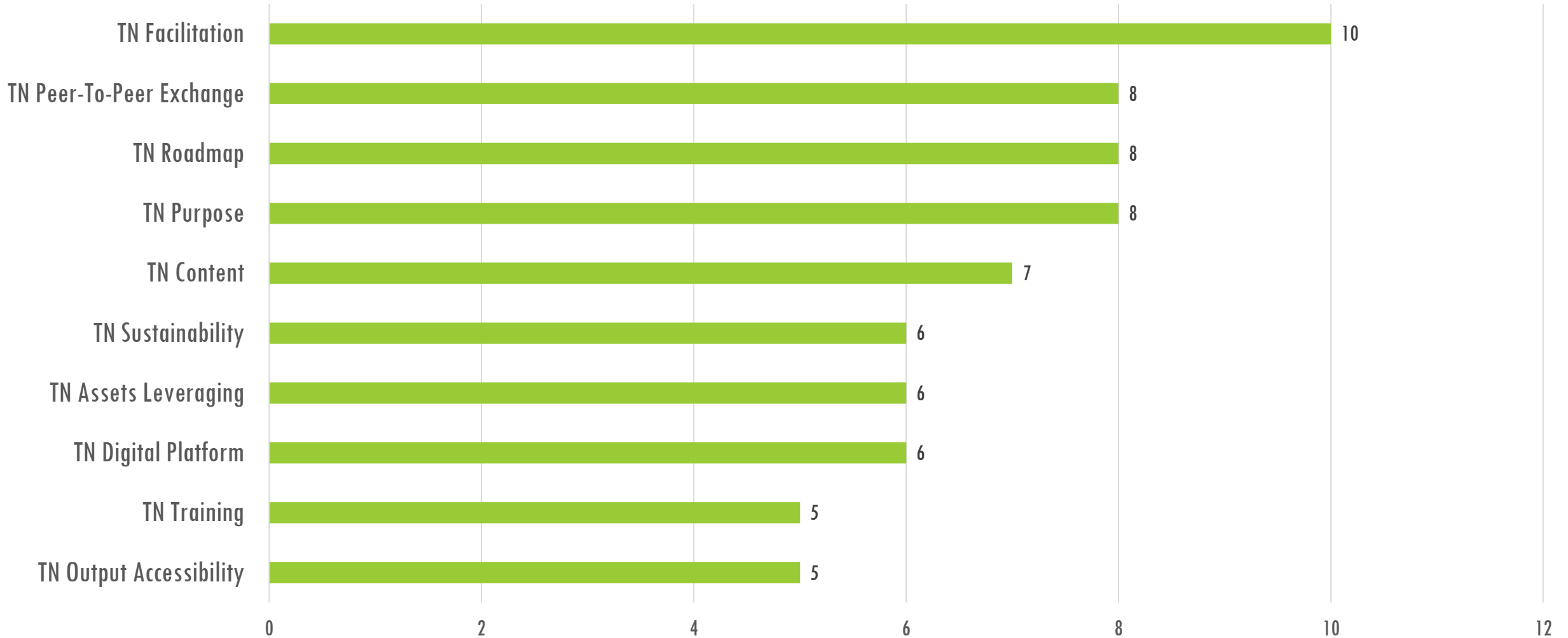
THE MULTI-ACTOR APPROACH IN PRACTICE

- Only some TN use directly the definition findable in H2020 guidelines
- For all TNs, MAA is understood as a mix of different types of actors with different backgrounds
- The MAA depends of the history, context, aim of the project (previous existing networks, context of the innovation carried out, purpose of the innovation, end-users targeted...)
- No one size fits for all
