Fuelling the competencies of advisors supporting interactive innovation, to respond to multiple challenges in European agriculture and forestry




Specific objectives

- **1. Strengthen the skills of advisors** to support interactive innovation, by:
 - identifying and sharing best practices
 - developing training contents, tools & methods
 - training and organising peer to peer learning & networking
- **2. Enhance the role of advisors** in interactive innovation processes at different levels, by:
 - a better understanding of the AKIS at country level
 - identifying providers of advisory services across Europe
 - creating an enabling environment within advisory services
 - > better embedding advisory services within AKIS and by appropriate public policies
- 3. Create a network among advisors facilitating innovation processes



Our main focus: the "innovation advisor"

- The interactive innovation dimension, relating to tasks where the advisor is engaged in multi-actor settings to support interactive innovation
- The professional community of practice dimension refers to the opportunity and capacity for an advisor to use professional networks for learning and self-development
- The enabling environment dimension includes the organisation in which the advisor works, the wider AKIS and the public policies as well


