1) Social innovation and inclusiveness in AKIS

• What are your country's needs?

Two over-arching crucial issues:

- Aging population
- Shrinking population

... which means:

- ➤ lack of staff, lack of tax payers (lack of resources)
- increased need for resourcefulness, including the necessary infrastructure, ICT solutions, collaboration (AKIS!), flexibility to recognise individual needs

1) Social innovation and inclusiveness in AKIS

- Which measures for social innovation and inclusiveness (funded by EU, national, regional or other, or non-funded) are being taken already?
- National support measure for temporary replacement of an agricultural producer in case of illness, caretaking of a child under 12, during pregnancy and maternity leave, holidays, or in case of death. Support rate 100%. Normally livestock etc, in COVID times also crops.
- In RDP, innovation cooperation measures (e.g., EIP OGs); advisory services (certificate in community development); LAGs, ...
- Which measures for social innovation and inclusiveness (funded by EU, national, regional or other, or non-funded) are being planned post 2020?
- ➤ The existing RDP measures remain available, but will be slightly modified more flexibility, more tailor-made approach, better access for new entrants in agriculture, consumers as the target group for knowledge transfer

2) Modern and interactive advisory services post 2020

• What are your country's needs?

- > To combat the insufficient number of advisors
- > Fighting the two evils aging and lack of motivation
- ➤ More flexibility needed in the system
- Which measures for modern and interactive advisory services, integrated within the AKIS, are being taken already (funded by EU, national, regional or other, or non-funded)?
 - Supported advice (Art 13) provided
 - ➤ Rural Development Foundation as the coordinating institution supporting advisors, acting as the contact point for clients/advisors (national level)
 - Training programmes for advisors

2) Modern and interactive advisory services post 2020

- Which measures for modern and interactive advisory services, integrated within the AKIS, are being planned post 2020 (funded by EU, national, regional or other, or non-funded)?
- > The existing support measures continue to be available, but with some modifications
- ➤ To grow the next generation of advisors → targeted support scheme for new advisors (headhunting + training), retired advisors as mentors for newbies, etc
- To motivate the existing advisory staff \rightarrow motivation, career path, various types of (obligatory) training (work shadowing, joint study trips/bus seminars for farmers/advisors/researchers, CECRA).
- > Coordination and support structure for advisory services, promoting advisory services to clients
- Collaboration (mixing supported+not supported advisors, advisors+researchers, etc), integration with other AKIS players
- Diversified formats: individual advice, group actions (e.g. discussion group), online consultations, mentoring, vouchers, self-service in knowledge reservoir,....
- > Special attention: new entrants in agriculture (relaxed eligibility requirements).
- Advice on processing will be available
