What do you do in your CAP AKIS plan to enhance knowledge flows and strengthening links between research and practice ?

- We expect all actors to contribute to the AKIS system:
 - Advisor need to get Permanent Education points, by meetings with research, education or government
 - Researchers need to publish on Green Knowledge net, and be active in co-creation of research (public/ private partnerships)
 - Education has its role in AKIS (see presentation)
 - Governments (local and national) need to get involved more in AKIS
- Networking is essential: great role for the CAP network
 - Organising meetings between partners in AKIS
 - Sharing data on different activities in AKIS
 - Central meeting point



What do you do in your CAP AKIS plan to integrate farm advisory services within the AKIS?

- see presentation on Thursday
- Explain what AKIS is
- Last 2 years large effort in organising and supporting impartial advice
 - Registration\ BAS
 - Permanent education points (research, government)
- Training for all advisors within 'innovation on the farmyard' by higher education
- Active addressing advisors to participate in CAP network
- Stimulate crossovers between research and advisors (meetings, joined projects)



What do you do in your CAP AKIS Plan to encourage interactive innovation projects (OGs, thematic networks, Horizon 2020 MA projects....)

- There is a large interest from farmers and other actors to join OG (lack of money to support all)
- Stimulate specific topics: short supply chain, regional aspects, digitalisation
- CAP network will show good examples and encourage cooperation between OG's (f.i. to thematic networks)
- NCP for Horizon cluster 6 will actively be involved with the CAP network
- Working on support to establish OG



What do you do in your CAP AKIS Plan to support digital transition serving effective AKIS?

- Digitalisation is a instrument more than a goal
- Digitalisation on knowledge dissemination by GKN, websites, digital meetings, apps etc.
- High interest for precision agriculture, with field labs, demonstration, knowledge exchange, investement
- Exchange of data, for conditionalities, marked demands, eco-scheme.
- Digitalisation to support monitoring
