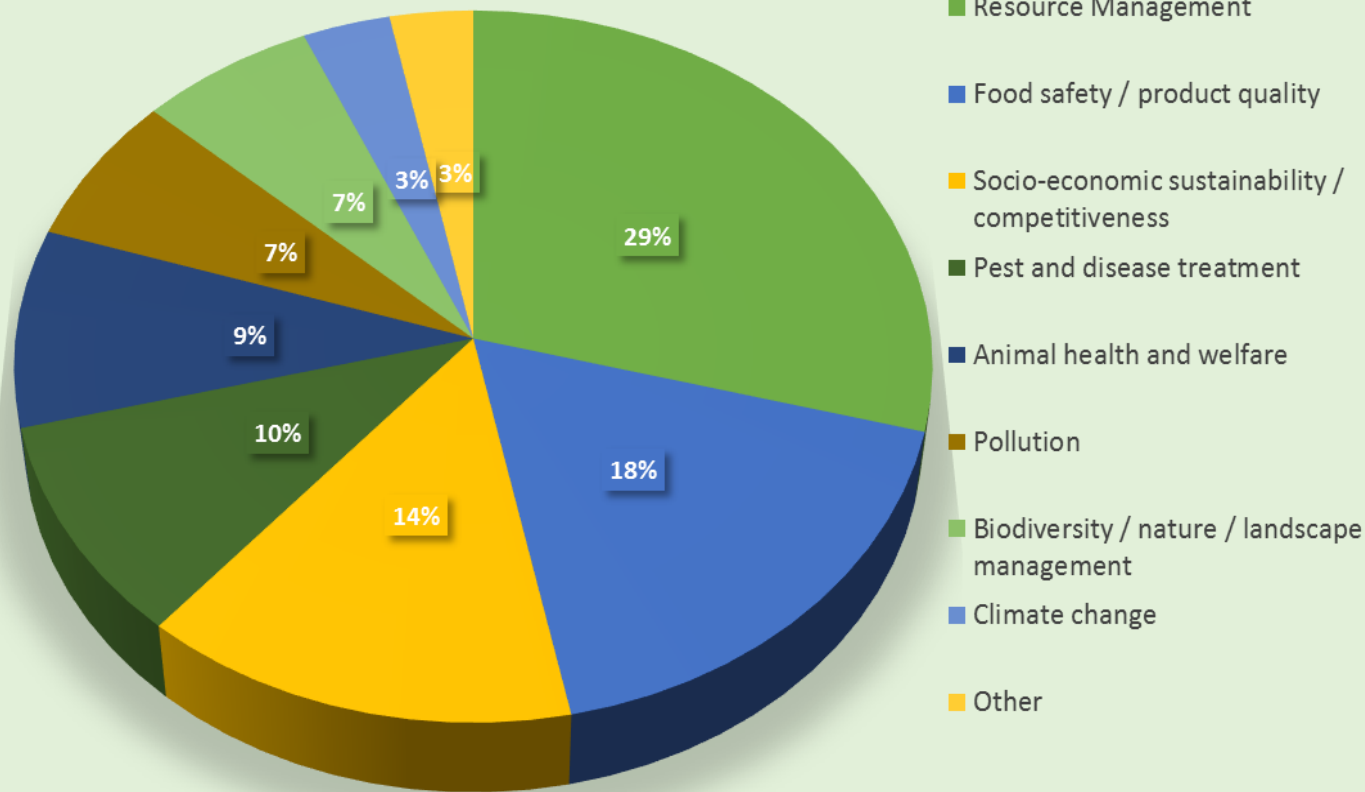

OG assessment – clustering analysis

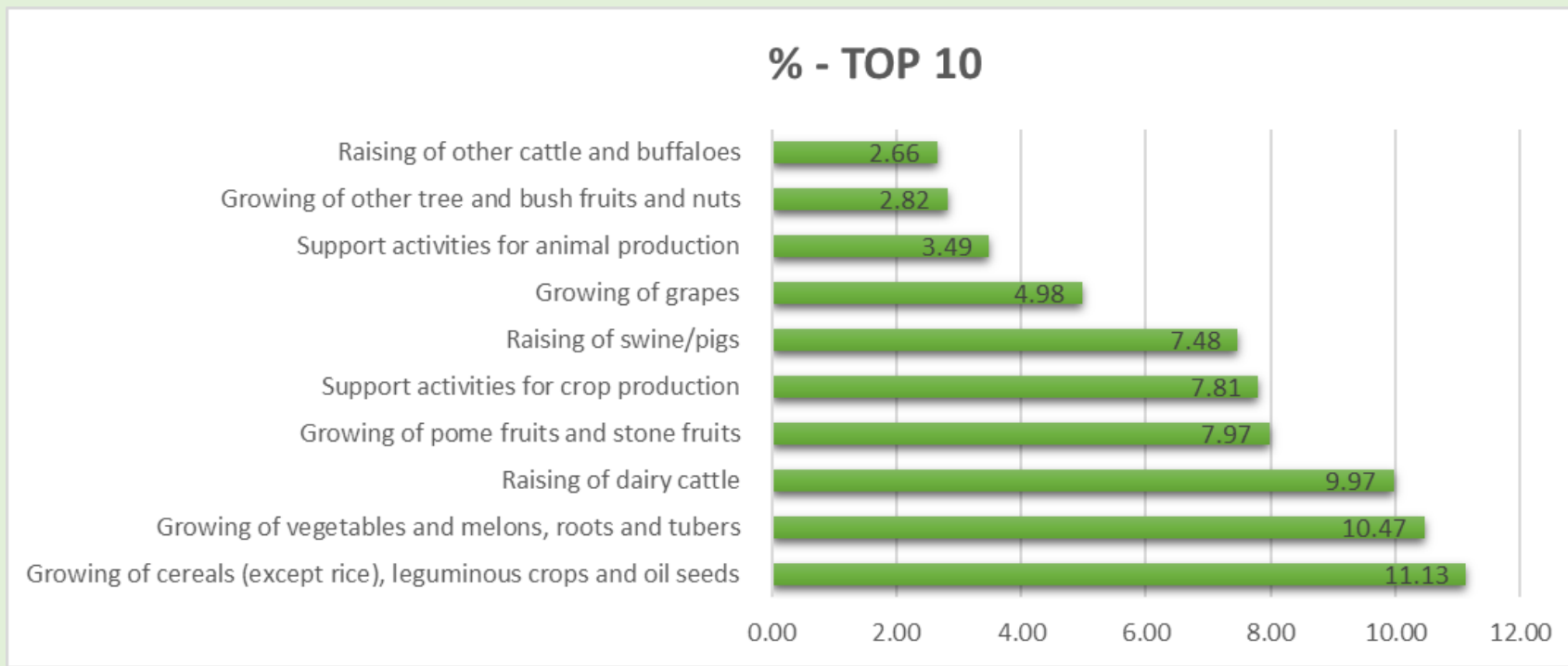


Type of agricultural challenge / opportunity faced (600 OG, 14 MS)

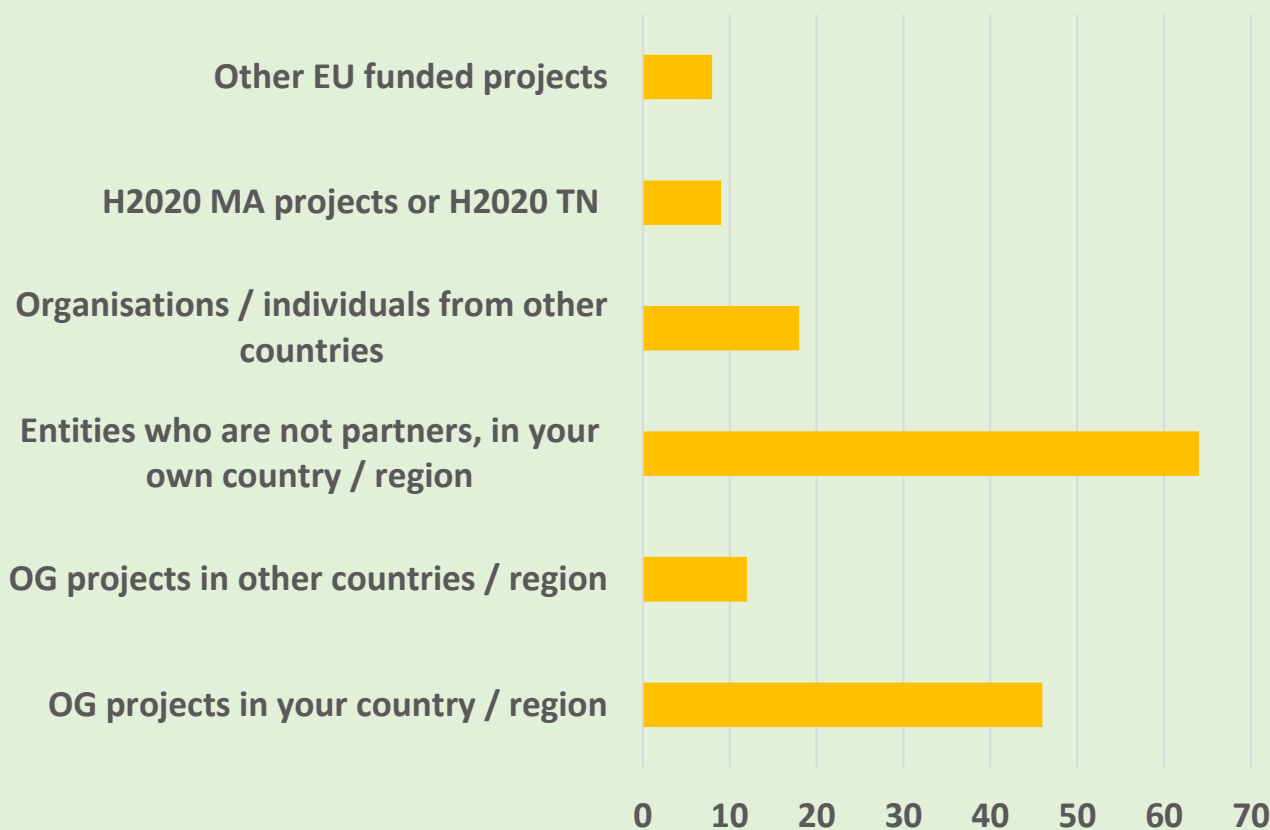
OG assessment – clustering analysis

Product / sector ranked by occurrence (600 OG projects, 14 MS)



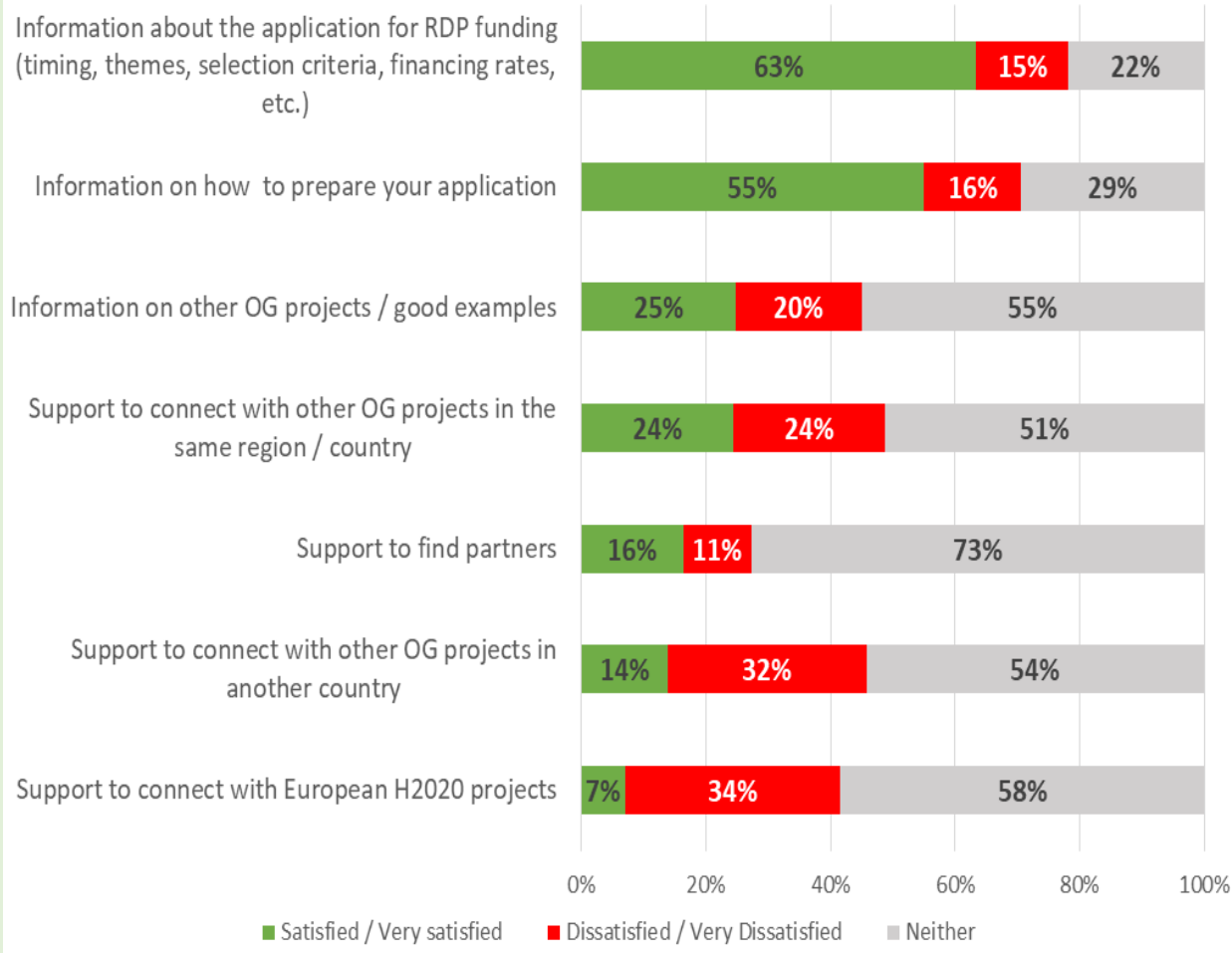
